MALLORY FEY TALKS ABOUT BUCK SKIN BRIGADES CAMP

HI. I'M MALLORY FEY AND I ATTENDED THE SOUTH TEXAS BUCKSKIN BRIGADE IN LA PRYOR, JUNE 11-15. I HAD A LOT OF FUN THIS YEAR AT THE CAMP, AND I AM HOPING TO BE ABLE TO GO BACK NEXT YEAR AS AN ASSISTANT HERD LEADER. I LEARNED A LOT ABOUT DEER AT THE CAMP SUCH AS HOW TO SCORE DEER, AGE DEER ON THE HOOF AND BY THEIR TEETH, NUTRITION AND FOOD FOR DEER, DEER ANATOMY, LAND MANAGEMENT TO PROTECT DEER, AND MANY OTHER THINGS. WE ALSO LEARNED ABOUT LEADERSHIP, CONSERVATION, AND BEING GOOD LAND STEWARDS TO PROTECT OUR NATURAL RESOURCES. MAJORITY OF THE LEADERS AT THE CAMP HAVE PROFESSIONS IN WILDLIFE AND SO WE WERE ABLE TO ASK THEM QUESTIONS AND LEARN ABOUT THEIR JOBS. MY FAVORITE THING WE DID AT CAMP WAS WHEN THE GAME WARDENS CAME OUT. THEY PRETENDED TO BE THE BAD GUYS AND WE PRETENDED TO BE THE GAME WARDENS. WE HAD TO FIND ALL THE THINGS THEY DID THAT WERE WRONG AND THEN FIND A SOLUTION TO FIX IT. WE WERE THEN ABLE TO ASK QUESTIONS ABOUT BEING A GAME WARDEN AND THE TRAINING NEEDED TO BECOME A GAME WARDEN. AT CAMP WE WERE PUT INTO GROUPS THAT WERE CALLED HERDS. I WAS IN AN ALL-GIRL HERD, AND WE ENDED UP WINNING THE TOP HERD AWARD AND EARNED A MANAGEMENT DEER HUNT DURING THIS UPCOMING DEER SEASON. OVERALL, I LOVED THIS CAMP, AND I WOULD RECOMMEND IT TO ANYONE WHO WANTS A JOB IN WILDLIFE OR EVEN IF SOMEONE JUST WANTS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT WILDLIFE.
